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RESEARCH SPOTLIGHT – CHRISTOPHER MUELLER

This month's research spotlight focuses on a research study by Christopher Mueller, that looks into – retrospective analyses of patient flow in mental health services in South London during the Covid-19 pandemic.

The study aims to investigate patient flow in and out of community mental health services for older adults during the first and second wave of the covid-19 pandemic.

In this retrospective analyses of mental health services, they used caseload, referrals and discharges from March 2019 to February 2021 using data from the Clinical Record Interactive Search (CRIS) system.

CRIS provides researchers access to more than 500,000 anonymised mental health and dementia records for patients under the South London and Maudsley NHS Foundation Trust (SLaM) and has full approval for secondary analysis by the Research Ethics Committee C.
